



# Mobile Heating Appliances Burning Liquid Fuel

Free movement of goods is ensured by the harmonisation of technical regulations at European level and, where the legislation is not harmonised, by the principle of “mutual recognition”. Below is information on mobile heating appliances burning liquid fuel.

## Scope

A mobile heating appliance burning liquid fuel is understood to mean any heating appliance using liquid fuel that does not need to be connected to a flue for smoke or fuel product waste to work.

Mobile heating appliances burning liquid fuel and the spare parts designed for these appliances (a list can be found in Appendix III to Decree no. 92-1280) can only be manufactured, imported, held for the purpose of sale or for free distribution, placed on sale, sold, rented or freely distributed if they are manufactured, marked and labelled so as to ensure safety against poisoning, burns or fire hazards.

## Regulations

Regulation is not harmonised at European level

### French regulation
